

fourth chapter 99 and also under and by virtue of the 5<sup>th</sup> Geo. the 4<sup>th</sup> Chapter 63 to amend the same to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Templemore in the County of Tipperary, they the said commissioners did certify that the true and just amount of the composition for all tithes whatsoever in the said Parish was £641 British, by the year and that of that sum £420 British, annually was due and payable to John Lloyd Esquire as Rector inpropriate of the said Parish; and the sum of £221 British, annually was due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Harry Meggs Graves the Vicar of said Parish which sums of £420 to the Lay Impropiator and of £221 to the Vicar the said commissioners therein stated were certified by them in consequence of an agreement made between the said Tithe Owners and a special vestry of said Parish on the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1828 to which agreement the consent of His Grace the archbishop of Cashel had been obtained.

And the said commissioners further certified that the average price

of wheat being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of 7 years ending the 1<sup>st</sup> November 1821 was £113-8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> late Irish currency per barrell.

And whereas under the provisions of the statute 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Victoria cap 109 Rent charges payable out of the lands in said parishes have been substituted for said composition.

And Whereas the said Sir John Craven Carden, Peter Charles Galbraith Westlake and Michael Corcoran being Three owners of land in said Parish each chargeable with the annual payment of £3 and upwards in respect of said Rent charge did by notice in writing duly signed by them and duly posted and published on the 20<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> days of September 1891 at the place and in the manner directed by the said acts signify their intent to make an application to us the said Justices assembled at the above mentioned Quarter Sessions to have said composition and Rent charge in lieu thereof or so much thereof as is liable to variation
