

by the barrel and consenting that same should be so taken and found by us upon such application and upon hearing what was offered by the said counsel for the said Henry Jesse Lloyd no evidence having been given or offered on his behalf we the said justices at the said Quarter Sessions assembled do hereby declare and state as follows that is to say.

We have found and hereby find that the corn principally grown in the said County Tipperary for this 7 years next preceding the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1891 and upon which such certificate was based was wheat and that the average price of good marketable wheat for said period in said County was £1-18-8½ late Irish currency equivalent to £1-15-9 British per barrel and that the average price of wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette for the 7 years preceding the said application was £0-18-7½ per barrel.

And we do hereby Order and direct that the said annual composition for Lay or Improprate Tithes in the said Parish of Templemore be varied in proportion to the said average price

of wheat and we hereby ascertain and fix the annual composition for the Lay or Improprate Tithes in the said parish of Templemore for the 7 years commencing 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1891 at the sum of £218-16-2½ in lieu of the said annual composition of £420, so as aforesaid found by the said certificate and until the same shall be again varied pursuant to the provisions of the said several statutes or any act or acts amending the same and we do hereby further find and ascertain that the Tithe Rent charge payable in lieu of said composition in said parish amon. to the sum of £164-2-2 and we order that the appratment be amended accordingly.

And we order and direct that all said parties do bear their own costs of said application.
