the fourth entitled an act to provide for the establishing  
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to  
ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all  
Tithes arising growing yielding or paying and payable  
within the Parish of Templepatrick in the County of Carlow  
do hereby certify that the true and just amount for Com-  
position for all Tithes Whatever, within said Parish is  
Sixty four Pounds Ten Shillings Sterling by the year being  
the sum by me ascertained and fixed upon which sum is  
due and payable to the Rev. James Williams Rector of  
said Parish and I do hereby certify that the average  
price of Wheat being the corn principally growing in  
the County of Carlow for 1830 is one pound Twelve  
Shillings and six pence half pence per barrel
