

Mr. John Rogers of Roschill and Francis Smiley of Comaghe
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made
in the 4th year of the Reign of George the 4th entitled an Act to
provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for
a limited Time, to ascertain and fix a True and Just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, specified or payable within the Parish
of Templepat in the County of Cork, do hereby Certify that the true
and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is Three hundred pounds Sterling by the year, which Sum of Three
hundred pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Rev^d William Bristow
as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said
Parish.

And we do further Certify that the average price of Oats being the
Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending
First November 1821 is five ~~ten~~ ^{two pence half penny} Shillings per Barrel.
