 pounds Sterling by the year which sum is
 due & payable to the Revd. William Rucker
 as a composition for all Tithes claimable by
 him as Rector of said Parish - And we do
 further certify, that the average price of oats
 being the corn principally grown in said County
 for the period of seven years ending on the first
 day of May 1821 - is 15.22 p^{rs} Ransel -
 Templeport Oct. 31st 1820 -
