

By the Justices assigned to keep the Peace,
in and for the County of Cork, assembled at a General
Sessions of the Peace, holden at Bandon in and for
the Division of Bandon in Cork County West Riding
on the Twentyfourth day of October, One thousand eight
hundred and fiftyfour.

Whereas due notice of application having been first affixed at the times and in the manner directed
by the statute in such Case made and provided by John Edward Kenrick, John O'Hea, Thomas Lucas
and Richard Wheeler, Esquires four persons Owners of land, in the Parish of Templequinnan, in the
Diocese of Cork, Division of Bandon, and West Riding of the County of Cork, each charged with
the Annual payment of the Sum of three Pounds and upwards, in respect of the Rent Charge, payable
in lieu of the Composition for Tithes, within such Parish made by the Certificate of John Kidd, bearing
date the Eleventh day of March, One thousand eight hundred and thirtyfour, and in pursuance of the
Statutes in such Case made and provided And whereas the gross Amount of Composition for all
Tithes, whatever in the said Parish was Certified to be the Annual Sum of Two hundred and thirty
Pounds One Shilling and Eight pence, the said four Owners of Land, made applica-
tion in writing to the Justices of the Peace, at the Quarter Sessions above mentioned, to have the Average
price of the Grain, in the Certificate mentioned for the preceding Seven years in the Statutes, in that
behalf mentioned Enquired of and ascertained, in order that the said Composition for Tithes, and the
Tithe Rent Charge in lieu of such Composition might be diminished, according to such Average
price as compared with the price of said Grain as set forth in said Certificate,
And whereas, it was by said Certificate Certified that the Average price of Wheat, during
the Seven years ending the First day of November One thousand Eight hundred and thirty-
was One Pound twelve Shillings and a halfpenny per Barrel, and that the price of Oats, during
same period was twelve Shillings and Seven pence halfpenny per Barrel, and that
Wheat and Oats were the Corn principally grown in said County. And whereas,
the said Applicants and the Duke of Devonshire, who Claims to be Entitled to a
Majority of the Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes, Composition within said Parish
having appeared before the said Justices by their Counsel and Agents at such Quarter
Sessions, and the said Notice of application Certificate and the Average price of wheat, and
Oats respectively as advertized, in the Dublin Gazette, for the said hereinbefore first mentioned
period of Seven years having been proved, Now the said Justices, do ascertain
from the said Gazette, that the Average price of Wheat, for the said period of Seven
years hereinbefore first mentioned is One Pound seven Shillings and two pence, for each
Bund of Twenty Stone, and that the Average price of Oats, for the same period is Seven
