

By the Justice assigned to Keep the
Peace in & for the Co^y of York, assembled
at a Genl. Sessions of the Peace holden
at Baileon in & for the Division of Baileon
in York County West Riding on the
24 Oct^r 1854-

Whereas due Notice of Application has been first affixed
at the times & in the manner directed by the Statute in such
Case made & provided by John E. Horriok. Jno^o Wm^o Wm^o Wm^o
& P^r Whaler Esq^s 4 Messons owners of Land in the Parish
of Templequinn in the Co^y of York, Division of Baileon, &
West Riding of the Co^y of York, each charged with the sum^o
payable of the sum of £3 0^o 0^o, in respect of the Rent Charge
payable in lieu of the Composition for tithes within the
Parish, made by the Certif^c of John Kirk bearing date
the 11th day of March 1834, & in pursuance of the Statute
in such Case made & provided - And Whereas the Gross
amt^o of Composition for all tithes whatever within the
said Parish was certified to be the sum^o of £230. 1. 8^d
the said 4 owners of Land made application in writing
to the Justice of the Peace at the Quarter Sessions
above ment^d to have the average price of the Grain
in the Certif^c ment^d for the preceding 7 years in the
Statute in that behalf ment^d enquired of & ascertained
in order that the said Composition for tithes, of the
tithes Rent Charge in lieu of such Composition might
be diminished according to such average price
as compared with the price of said Grain
as set forth in said Certificate -
