 do hereby certify that the true and just amount of
 Composition for all Tythes whatever within the said Parish is
 Three Hundred and Fifty Pounds by the Year which
 sum of Three Hundred and Fifty ^{Pounds} is due and payable to
 the Rev. Francis Stawell as Rector of the said Parish. And
 We do further certify that the average price of Wheat being
 the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of
 Seven years ending on the first day of November One Thou=
 sand Eight Hundred and Twenty One is One Pound Eighteen
 Shillings and eight pence halfpenny late Irish Currency
 Dated this 31st day of October 1829 and Twenty Nine

 subject to any variation in the amount thereof for the Term of Twenty One
 Years from the first day of November next ensuing the date of said Certi=
 ficate whatever the price of Corn may be in the mean time Given under
 our hands this 18th day of January 1830 and Thirty
