and to make such composition permanent" to ascertain  
& fix a true and just composition for all tythes arising  
growing yielded or payable within the parish of Temple  
Togher & County of Galway do hereby certify that  
the true and just amount of composition for all tythes  
whosoever within the said parish due and payable to  
the rector of the union of Kiltullagh out of the said parish  
of Temple Togher being one fourth part of the whole tythes  
of the said parish is twenty nine pounds thirteen  
shillings and eight pence

And I further certify that the average price of  
Oats being the grain principally grown in the said  
County for the period of seven years ending on the  
first day of November 1830 (thirty); twelve shillings &  
eleven pence half penny per barrel -
