duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act
made in the 2nd & 3rd year of the reign of King William
the fourth entitled "An act to amend three acts passed
respectively in the 14th, 5th and 7th & 8th years of the reign of his
late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the es-
tablishing of compositions for tithes in Ireland and to
make such compositions permanent" to ascertain and fix
a true and just composition for all tithes arising, growing
yielded or payable within the quarter parish of Templeogue
and county of Galway - do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of composition for all tithes whatever within
the said quarter parish is twenty nine pounds thirteen
shillings and eight pence by the year, of which sum of
Twenty nine pounds thirteen shillings and eight pence the
whole is due and payable to the Rector of the said quarter
parish - And I do further certify that the average price
of oats - being the grain principally grown in the said county
for the period of seven years ending on the first day of
November 1831 (one) is twelve shillings and eleven pence
half penny per barrel
