Tamplewsey in the County of Cork. Do hereby  
certify that the true and just amount of Composition  
for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish  
Three hundred and sixteen pounds the Tithes  
year payable to the Rev. Edward St Laurence  
as Rector and Vicar of said Parish pursuant  
to an agreement entered into by the said Edward  
St Laurence and a Special vestry of said Parish

And we do further Certify that the average  
price of Oats "being the Corn principally grown in  
said County" for the period of seven years ending  
the first day of November one thousand eight hundred  
and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence  
fourth part per barrel. Dated the twenty second  
day of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty
