the Establisment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time and also of an Act made in the
Fifth year of the reign of King George the fourth
entitled an Act to amend an Act of the last session
of Parliament for providing for the redemption of
Tithes in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and
just composition for all Tithes arising growing
or yielding or payable within the Parish of
Templevishey in the County of Cork. Do hereby
certify that the true and just amount of composition
for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is
Three hundred and sixteen pounds the by the year
payable to the Rev. Edward Lawrence as Rector
and Vicar of said Parish pursuant to an agreement
entered into by the said Rev. Edward Lawrence and
a special Vestry of said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of oats being the Corn principally grown in
said County for the period of seven years ending
the first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one is fifteen shillings and two pence
farthing per barrel. Dated this Twenty second
