the said Parish is Fifty eight Pounds one Shilling British  
by the Year. And We do further certify that the Average  
Price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such  
County for the period of Seven years ending on the 31<sup>st</sup> day  
of December 1820 - 1-18:8 1/2 per Barrel -
