

We The Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under  
and by virtue of an Act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the Reign of  
King George The Fourth, intituled "an Act to provide for  
the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
Time", to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition  
for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within  
the Parish of Thomastown in the County of Kildare, do hereby  
certify that, the true and just Amount of Composition for all  
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Fifty eight Pounds one  
Shilling Sterling by the Year. Which Sum of Fifty eight Pounds  
one Shilling Sterling, is due and payable to him The Rev<sup>d</sup>  
Henry Hamilton as a Composition for the Tithe claimable  
by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish. And We do further  
certify that the Average Price of Wheat, being the Corn principally  
grown in said County for the period of seven years next preceding  
1821 one is one pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence  
half penny per Barrel -
