I John Wickham Sole Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the 2^d and 3^d Year of His present Majesty William the 4th Cap 119 entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th and in the 7th and 8th Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Composition permanent } to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Thomastown in the County of Kilkenny do hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Two hundred and forty eight Pounds 5th by the Year due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Cooke as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish.

And I do further certify that the Average Price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the Period of seven Years ending on the 4th day of November 1830 is £1.12.0^{rs} per Barrel.
