The Second Class Contains 1370-3-21<sup>st</sup> Acs, and includes all lands valued at 18<sup>th</sup> and from that sum down-wards to thirteen shillings & four pence. This Class is rated at 2-1/2<sup>th</sup> per acre and the total annual amount of Composition for this Class is £145-14-16<sup>th</sup>. It is to be observed that the Second Class Contains the Largest sum of acres in the Applotment and is rated at the average rateable charge for Composition in the Parish viz 2-1/2<sup>th</sup> per acre.

The Third Class Contains 275-2-23<sup>rd</sup> Acs and includes all Lands valued at 12<sup>th</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> per acre and under. This Class is rated at 1-2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> per acre and the total annual Am<sup>t</sup> of Composition for this Class is £15-11-2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>.
