

Tithe Composition
Parish of Timahoe
Certificate.

I, William R. Sterling Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act, made in
the Second and Third year of the Reign of King
William the Fourth intituled ("An act to amend three
Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in
the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late
Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
and to make such Compositions permanent.") to ascertain
and fix a true Composition for all Tithes arising
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Timahoe
in the County of Kildare, do hereby certify that the
true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatevur within the said Parish is Two Hundred and
Thirty eight Pounds by the year, which sum of
Two Hundred & thirty eight Pounds is due and Payable to
the Reverend Arthur Smith Adamson as a Composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the
said Parish; And I do further Certify
that the average price of wheat, being the Corn prin-
cipally grown in such County for the period of seven
years ending on the first Day of November 1830.
(Thirty) is Thirty two Shillings and one halppenny Sterling
per Barrel. (Signed.) William R. Sterling.
