and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes
arising growing, yielded or payable within the
Parish of Trenchard and Tully in the Queen's County,
do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish, is Four hundred and twenty pounds
by the year: of which sum of Four hundred and
twenty pounds, Two hundred and eighty pounds
being two third parts, are due and payable to
to Henry Moore Esq: as a Composition for the
Tithes claimable by him, as Lessee of John Home Esq:
as lay Impropriator of the Rectorial Tithes: and
One hundred and Forty pounds being One third part
