

By The Justices assigned to Keep the
Peace in and for the County of Cork assembled
at a General Session of the Peace holden at
Blmarilly in and for the Division of Brandon
in the West Riding of the County of Cork on
the Ninth day of July 1855 -

Whereas due notice having been first
affixed at the times and in manner directed by the
Statute in such case made and provided by Augustus
Thames, Sampson Beamish, Thomas Beamish, Jonas Lawton
and Robert Travis Esqrs. five persons owners of land in the
Parish of Timoleague in the West Riding of the County of
Cork each charged with the annual payment of the sum
of three pounds six and upwards in respect of the rent charge
payable in lieu of the composition for tithes within said
Parish made by the Certificate of Composition bearing date
the Twenty third day of January One Thousand Eight hundred
and Twenty Eight in pursuance of the Statute in such case
made and provided, whereby the gross amount of composition
for all tithes whatever in said Parish was certified to be
the annual sum of Four Hundred and Thirteen
Pounds Eight Shillings and Eight pence half
penny Sterling. They the said five owners of land made
application in writing to the Justices of the Peace at the Quarter
Sessions above mentioned to have the average price of wheat
being the grain in said Certificate mentioned, inquired
of and ascertained in order that the said composition
for tithes and the tithes rent charge in lieu thereof might
be diminished according to such average price as compared
with the price of One pound Eighteen shillings and Eight
pence halfpenny of the late Irish currency per Barrel
as set forth in said Certificate, And Whereas
the said applicants, and the Rev. Charles Coughlan
Prebendary and Vicar of the said Parish having appeared
by their Counsel or agents before the said Justices at such
Quarter -
