

Quarter Sessions, and the said notice of application, and Certificate, and the average price of wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette for the said period of seven years having been proved. Now the said Justices do ascertain from the said Gazette that the average price of wheat for the said period of seven years is One pound Eight shillings and five pence and three fourths of one penny etc. for each Barrel of twenty stone. And the said Justices do accordingly Order and adjudge that the amount of said composition in said Parish and the rent charges payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in proportion to the difference between the said average price of One pound Eighteen shillings and eight pence half penny in late Irish Currency as stated in said Certificate, and the said sum of £ 1. 0. 5 1/4 Muls being the average price of wheat for the last seven years as ascertained for the Dublin Gazette, and that the apportionment of such composition shall be amended accordingly, and the said Justices do further order that said reduction shall take effect from the first day of May one thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty six.
