yielding and payable within the parishes and vicarage of Simolough
in the County of Wick, and Diocese of Cork, do hereby Certify that
the true and just amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever
within the said Parishes is Three hundred and seventy Pounds
sterling by the Year of which the entire sum is due payable to
the Rev^d Charles Sargison as parson and vicar
of said Parishes, and that the said sum of Three hundred and
seventy Pounds shall be invariably for the Term of 21 Years
from the first day of September next, without any abatement
to the price of Corn, Dated this 16th day of
September 1824
