 duly assembled in the Parish Church of Simolague in and for
 the Parish of Simolague in the Diocese of Ross and County of
 Ross on the Twenty eighth day of May one thousand eight
 Hundred and Twenty seven to give into Execution the
 Purposes of the acts of the 4th and 5th of George 4th
 Entitled an act or acts to provide for the settling
 of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time
 was agreed upon by and between the majority of said
 Voters to the number of ~~seven~~ and the Reverend
 Charles Ferguson Incumbent of said Parish of Simolague
 agree that the said Reverend Charles Ferguson Incumbent
 as aforesaid should receive each and every year the
 sum of ~~Three hundred and twenty pounds~~ that the said Parish
 of Simolague should pay to him the said Reverend Charles
 Ferguson Incumbent as aforesaid the Annual sum of
~~Three hundred and twenty pounds~~ as a composition for and
 in lieu of and for all tithes arising growing yielding
 and payable within said Parish of Simolague
 and that the same agreement shall hold good
 and be binding between both parties for the term and
 space of Twenty one years from the date hereof without
 Reference to the piece of coin in Witness whereof we the
 Undersigned have set our hands this Twenty eighth day of
 May one thousand eight Hundred and twenty seven
