 under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of
 the Reign of King George the fourth Entitled an Act to
 provide for the Establishing a Composition for Tithes in
 Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and
 just Composition for all Tithes arising from any yields
 or payable within the Parish of Sanctus in the County
of Wicklow -

We hereby certify that the true and
 just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever
 within the said Parish is one Hundred and thirty one
 Pounds five Shillings by the year, of which sum of One
 Hundred and thirty one Pounds five Shillings, One
 third part is due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Callington
 as Composition for Tithes claimable by him as Incumbent
 Incumbent of said Parish, and two thirds is due and payable
 to the Vicar and Tithe Curates of said Church and
 St. Patrick's Dublin as Curates of said two thirds.

And we do further certify that
 the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
 grown in said County for the period of seven years
 ending on the first Day of November One thousand
 Eight Hundred and Twenty One, is One pound fifteen
 Shillings and Eight pence Half penny of the Pound.
