

At a vestry called by public notice according to the tenor of the Act of the fourth of George the fourth Chapter 99. for the purpose of bringing the Parish of Timolin in the County of Wick under the provisions of said Act.

It was resolved.

That the Landholders of said Parish agree to pay the Incumbent the sum of Sixty three pounds fifteen Shillings Sterling of Annam for his portion of the Tithe of said Parish by two equal half yearly payments on the first Day of May and first Day of November in each year.

This Agreement to be in force for the term of Twenty One years.

That the Landholders also agree to pay the Vicar and Minor canons of the Cathedral of Christ Church and St. Patrick's Dublin the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Seven pounds ten Shillings of Annam according to the tenor of the above agreement.

That Mr. James may be hereby appointed a Commissioner to carry this Act into Execution on the part of the Landholders.

Done this Sixth day of July 1824.

This Vestry is hereby adjourned to the 20th Day of July Inst.

It was resolved.

That the Landholders of said Parish agree to pay the Incumbent of said Parish, the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Six pounds Sterling of Annam for his portion of the Tithe of said Parish in two half yearly payments on the first Day of May and the first Day of November in each year.

That this agreement be in force for the term of Twenty One years.

That the said Landholders agree to pay to the Chapl. of St. Patrick's Dublin the sum of two Hundred and fifty two pounds Sterling of Annam according to the tenor of the above agreement.

That the Rev. John Paget be hereby appointed Commissioner to carry this Act into execution on the part of the Landholders.

That this Vestry be adjourned to the 20th Day of July Instant.
