

J. Randle Patrick, Mardonell, Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the second and third years of the Reign of King William the fourth, in that an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and seventh years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing of a composition for tithes in Ireland, and to make such compositions permanent, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising, growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Tipper in the County of Kildare, do hereby certify, that the true and just composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is one hundred and seventy-eight Pounds Sterling by the year, of which sum of one hundred and seventy eight pounds, the sum of twenty six Pounds is due and payable to the legal representatives of the late Thomas Burch Esquire, as Proprietor of one third of the com. tithes of the town lands of Craddockstown and Tipper in said Parish, as composition for all tithes claimable by them, and the remaining sum of one hundred and fifty two Pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Walter Burch the Rector of the said Parish, as composition for all tithes claimable by him -

And I do further certify that the average price of wheat being the com principally grown in said County, for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1830 is one pound twelve Shillings and one halfpenny Sterling per barrel -
