 thirty eight Statutable Irish acres and we do therefore assess
 each acre to pay at the Rate of two shillings and one penny
 for the said Statutable Irish acres and so in proportion for Reeds and Patches - the
 same to be levied in each year upon the foregoing occupiers
 of the Respective lands in said Parish according to the
 act in that behalf made and provided as witness our
 hands this firsteenth day of December One thousand
 eight hundred and Twenty eight
