

We Abraham Sandys of Kiltormer and John Dowling of Longford Castle Esqrs Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth, intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Tynanascragh in the County of Galway, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Seventy seven pounds by the year, of which sum of Seventy seven pounds Sterling Thirty five pounds Sterling is due and payable to the Revd Richard Eyre as Vicar of the said Parish; Five pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Revd Sean Hawkins, and Thirty seven pounds Ster. is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Clonsfert:— And, we do further certify that the average price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 twenty one, is ten Shillings and six pence by the barrel:— Given under our hands and Seals this twenty second day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty four. —
