

To all to whom these Presents shall come - I the Rev^d Charles
Dunn incumbent of the Parish of Ferrara in the County of
Roscommon send greeting

Whereas Denis H. Kelly Esq of Castle Kelly in the County of
Galway, has truly served me with a notice in writing in the
words and figures following

"Sir you are hereby required to take notice that in pursuance
of an act passed in the second and third year of His present Majesty
entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth
fifth and in the seventh & eighth year of the reign of His late Majesty
King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions
for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent
I Denis Henry Kelly of Castle Kelly in the County of Galway being
seized in the free simple of all that & those the lands of
Arenasmalla bounded on the north by Debarney on the south
& west by Coolderry Debarney and on the east by Cloph
hatched, and being similarly seized of the lands of

Clonkeellegan bounded on the north by the lands
of Conglaine and the river Suik on the west by the river Suik on the
south by Tughboy and on East by Tinnrover and Clonloughnane

Donnellan and being similarly seized of the lands of Clonloughnane
commonly called Carton Kelly bounded on the North by Coracott on
the East by Concagh and Highfield and on the south and west by
Bealnabraith Tinnrover and Clonloughnane Donnellan situated in
the Parish of Ferraras Barony of Athlone and County of Roscommon
and being entitled according to the provisions of said Act to agree
for and undertake the payment of the Composition for Tithes lawfully
payable for and in respect of such lands Do hereby signify to you
my desire to agree for and undertake the future payment of such
Composition as aforesaid for and in respect of the said lands and
I hereby require you to grant me a Certificate in Writing conformable
to the provisions of said Act declaring me entitled to the benefit
of this Notice and to perform the other matters on your part required
by the said Act to be done. (Dated and signed by me this
