the powers and authorities vested and reposed
in me as a Commissioner for the parish of
Disert by virtue of an act passed in the fourth
year of the reign of King George the fourth
entitled an act to provide for the establishing
Composition for tithes in Ireland for a le-
mitted time according to the directions
of the said act and according to equity
and good conscience without favour or affec-
tion prejudice or malice to any person or per-
-sons whatsoever - dated this 31st day of October
- 1823 -
