

We William Kelly and William Shack Esq<sup>r</sup> Commissioners  
duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an act made in the  
fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth entitled an act  
to provide for the establishing of compensation for tithes in Ireland for  
a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just compensation  
for all tithes, arising, growing, yielded or payable within the parish  
of Tassara in the County of Down and diocese of Down

Do Hereby Certify that the true and just amount of  
Compensation for all tithes whatsoever within the said parish  
is One hundred and Eleven pounds thirteen Shillings, and  
four pence sterling by the year of which sum two fifths  
or Forty four pounds thirteen Shillings and four pence  
sterling is due and payable to the Right Honorable the Incorporated  
Society for establishing Charter Schools in Ireland  
as a Compensation for the tithes claimable by them as trustees  
proprietors of the Rectorial or impropriate tithes of said parish  
and three fifths or Sixty seven pounds sterling are due and payable  
to the Vicar of said parish as a compensation for the Vicarial  
tithes claimable by him — And we do further Certify that  
the average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in the  
parish of Tassara for the period of Seven years ending on the  
31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1830 is twelve Shillings and eleven pence  
half penny per Barrell Given under our hands at tith office  
the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December 1836
