position for all tithes arising growing yield-  
ed or payable, within the parish of Teybarogh  
in the county of Roscommon and Diocese  
of Elphin, do hereby certify, that the true  
and just amount of composition for all  
tithes whatever within the said parish  
is one hundred and eleven pounds thirteen  
shillings & four pence sterling by the year  
of which sum two fifths or forty four  
pounds thirteen shillings & four pence  
sterling are due and payable to the  
R<sup>ev</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Incorporated Society
