the second and third years of the reign of King William  
the fourth, entitled an act to amend three acts passed  
respectively the 4<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> years of His late Majesty  
King George the fourth providing for the Establishing of  
Composition for tithes in Ireland and to make such  
Composition permanent to ascertain and fix a true  
and just Composition for all tithes arising growing  
yielding and payable, within the Parish of Fassifern,  
in the County of Wicklow. Do hereby Certify, that the  
true and just amount, of Composition for all tithes  
whatsoever within the said Parish, is one hundred and eighty  
five pounds, by the year which sum is due and  
payable, to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Robt Sanderson, as rector of said  
parish, as a Composition for all tithes, Claimed by  
him, within said Parish, I do hereby further Certify,  
that the average price of wheat, being the Principal  
Corn grown in such County for the Period of seven years,  
ending first Nov<sup>r</sup> one Thousand Eight hundred and  
Thirty, is One pound twelve Shillings, and one half penny  
per barrel. dated this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 1834
