of King William the fourth intituled "An Act to amend three Acts  
passed respectively in the fourth and fifth and in the seventh and  
Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth  
proceeding for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland  
and to make said Compositions permanent," to ascertain and fix  
a true and Just Composition for all Tithes arising growing  
yielded or payable within the Parish of Kiltishan alias Kiltistin  
in the Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork. Do hereby  
Certify that the True and Just <sup>amount of</sup> Composition of ~~Composition~~  
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Shillings  
and One pound fourteen Shillings and Nine pence Sterling  
by the Year which entire Sum is due and payable to the Right  
Reverend John Dunkley D.D. Lord Bishop of Cloyne as a  
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar  
of the said Parish. And I do further Certify that the  
Average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown  
in such County for the Period of Seven years ending on the  
first day of November 1830 is One pound twelve Shillings  
and One half penny per Barrel. Dated this first day of
