the said parish is *Two Hundred and Ninety Nine*
pounds by the year as agreed on at Vestry
which sum of *Two Hundred and Ninety Nine*
pounds is due and payable to the *Vis. Roger*
Queen as aforesaid as a Composition for the
Tithes claimable by him as Rector of the
said parish ~~the said composition to be in force for~~
~~Twenty one years and not subject to Variation during that~~
~~period~~ *made this 14th day of Decr 1024*
