We John Thom Brownrigg and John Curson Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under an Act by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising ground rents or payable within the Parish of Tomb in the County of Wick do hereby certify that the fact and true amount of composition for all tithes what ever within the said Parish is two hundred and thirty nine pounds by the year the whole of which sum is due and payable to the Rev. Mr. Peter as Rector of said Parish and we do further certify that the average price of wheat being the best principally grown in such Parish for the period of seven years ending on the 31st day of October 1821 is thirty eight shillings and eight pence half penny per Bushel given under our hands this 14th day of December 1824
