

1st Resolved that this Special Vestry consisting of the foregoing Vestry men being sworn at the least so on behalf of the owners and occupiers of Lands in said Parish assent to and agree with the foregoing Certificate of the Commissioners of the annual amount of Composition payable out of said Parish to the His Majesty's Exchequer the sum thereof to be the sum of two hundred and ninety nine pounds 2^d Resolved that this Special Vestry do also on behalf of the owners and occupiers of Lands in said Parish signify their assent and agreement that such Composition of Two hundred and ninety nine pounds shall continue to be paid for such term of Twenty one years from the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and twenty five and shall not be subject to any variation in the amount thereof during such period twenty one years under the provisions of the said before recited act or of another act made in the fifth year of King George the fourth entitled an act to amend an act of the last session of Parliament for providing for establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland what ever the price of Tithes may be
