You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," I *George Dodwell of Kesh in the County*
of Sligo Esquire do and for *Sir Robert Gore Booth Bart*
who is seized in *Fee Simple* of all that and those *the Townland,*

*of Ballinacree, Rosrib, Lavilla, Curranacree,
Grunnaw, Grannaw, Clitta, Drinnagranah,
Kingsfort, Keshacree, Tinnaghrum, Derranacree
& Curranacree* containing Two Thousand six
hundred and fifty eight Acres, English Statute
Measure or thereabouts, the Meas and bounds,
whereof are delineated and set forth in the
Map or Plan Chart hereunto annexed which
said Lands are situate in the Parish of *Tommon*
Barony of Curran & County of Sligo

do hereby signify to you *by the Authority given to me and in behalf of*
Sir Robert Gore Booth Bart desire to agree for and undertake the payment of the Composition for Tythes
lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to *the said*
Sir Robert Gore Booth Bart a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring
Him entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other mat-
ters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
