

I certify that in the amount of Composition certified by me for the Vicarial Tithes of the Parish of Ferrisburgh to which this is annexed amounting to Five hundred and three pounds and eleven Shillings Sterling, I have included the average amount of Vicarial Tithes for the Townlands called the Templevannys and Fienmore in said Parish, as claimed by the Vicar for his Stipend, and from which The Right Honorable George Earl of Kingston claims exemption amounting to thirty five pounds five Shillings and one penny, so that if these Townlands be found to be exempt from the payment of Tithes to the Vicar, the Sum he should receive and be applied on the Remainder of the Parish for the Vicarial Tithes should be
