which deprived the Tithes Owner of his usual income
which would render it unjust towards any future
Incumbent to act upon this reduced income to form
a Certificate which together makes Two Hundred
Pounds Five Shillings _____ by the year due
and payable to the Rev. John, U. Swayne as a Com-
position for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector
and Vicar of the said Parish,

And I further certify that the average price
of wheat being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the period of seven years ending the first
day of November 1830 is One pound twelve shillings and
ten pence halfpenny per Barrel,
