Butler Commissioners duly appointed and sworn  
under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth  
Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth entitled  
an Act to provide for the settling of compositions  
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain  
and fix a true and just composition for all  
Tithes arising growing due or payable  
within the Parish of Trim in the County of Meath  
do hereby certify that the true and just Amount  
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the  
said Parish is Six Hundred and fifteen  
Pounds by the Year whereof the Sum of Four  
Hundred and thirty pounds is due and payable  
to Mr W Allen Lessee of the Rectorial Tithe as  
a composition for all Tithes claimable by him  
and the Sum of One Hundred and eighty five  
Pounds is due and payable to the Endowed  
Butler Vicar of the said Parish
