or Trubly in the County of Meath do hereby certify
that the true and just Amount of Composition
for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is
Fifty Pounds. ^{into his Majesty's} Of which sum of Fifty Pounds
the whole is due and payable to the Reverend
Richard Butler as Rector of the said Parish

of Wheat & Oats, the Corn principally grown in such
Parish for the Period of Seven Years ending on the
