

We Hugh Brady and Patrick Molony Commissioners  
duly Appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act  
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth  
Intituled, "An Act to provide for the establishment of  
Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time," to ascertain  
and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising  
growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Tulloh in  
the County of Clare, do hereby certify that the true and just  
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the  
said Parish is Four Hundred and twelve Pounds ten Shillings  
by the year, Of which sum of Four Hundred and twelve pounds  
ten Shillings, the sum of Three Hundred and eight pounds  
four Shillings and one penny are due and payable to the  
Rev. Richard Drew as a Composition for the Tithes  
claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the said  
Parish, One Hundred pounds is due and payable to Henry  
Honey Lessee of the Rev. Arthur Young half Rector of the said  
Parish and Four pounds five Shillings and eleven pence is  
due and payable to the Rev. William Deane Rector and  
Prebendary of Tangary who is entitled as such Prebendary  
to the said sum of Four pounds five Shillings and eleven  
pence for a certain proportion of Tithes of the Town Lands  
of Roslara in said Parish

And that such Composition shall continue to be  
levied for such Term of Twenty one years and shall not  
be subject to any Variation in the Amount thereof during  
said Twenty one Years under the Provisions of said Act.

And that whatever the Price of Coin may be  
Given under our Hands this 20<sup>th</sup> day of October  
1825
