Whereas due notice of application having been first affixed at
the time and in the manner directed by the Statutes in such case
made and provided by The Reverend Gerald Wensley Syrett
Incumbent of the Parish of Sullybrackey in the County of
Limerick being the party entitled to and in the actual receipt of
the Rent Charge in lieu of Composition for Tithes arising and
payable in respect of the Several Lands chargeable therewith
in the Parish of Sullybrackey in the said County of Limerick
and Division of Bruff in pursuance of a certain Certificate
bearing date the ^{twenty eighth} day of October 1833 whereby
the gross amount of ^{composition} all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish was certified to be the annual Sum of Two hundred
and eighty pounds ten Shillings and Sixpence. The said
Reverend Gerald Wensley Syrett Incumbent as aforesaid
made an application in Writing to the Justices of the Peace
at the said Sessions above mentioned to have the average price
of Oats being the Gram in the said Certificate mentioned
for the preceding Seven years in the Statutes in that behalf
mentioned enquired of and ascertained in order that the said
Composition and the Rent Charge in lieu thereof might be
varied and increased according to such average price as compared
with the price or Sum of twelve Shillings and eleven pence
halfpenny per Barrel being the price of Oats as set forth
in
