

Certificate of Composition for Tithes in
the Parish of Grove in the Diocese of Ely.

We John Wood of Sowerton and James Hayden of
Caherlish in the County of Wicklow Commissioners duly appointed
and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth Year of
the reign of King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the
establishment of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
time to wit for one year and first Composition for all
Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Grove in the Diocese of Ely and County of Wicklow. Do
Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Thirty
two pounds ten Shillings by the year of which sum of Two Hun-
dred and thirty two pounds ten Shillings two third parts are due
and payable to the Vicar Choral of Christ Church Dublin in their
Sepulchre as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by them as owners
of the Rectorial tithes, and one third part is due and payable to the
Reverend Archdeacon as owner of the Vicarual tithes of said Parish

And we do further Certify that the Average price of
wheat being the Corn principally grown in the County of Wicklow
for the period of seven years ending the first of November 1828
is One pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence per Barrel
