Quarter Sessions held at
Thomastown in and for
said County of Kilkenny on
the 17th day of October 1870

In the matter of an
application to vary
the Tithe Rent Charge
of the Parish of Grove
or Tullahanbroque in
the County of Kilkenny

Whereas it appearing to the
Chairman and Justices presiding
at the Quarter Sessions of the
Peace for the County of Kilkenny
held at Thomastown in said
County on the 17th day of October
1870 that Lord Desart, Michael

Cahill Esq and M^{rs} Johanna Hogan being
three Landholders in the Parish of Grove
or Tullahanbroque in the Diocese of Ross in
the County of Kilkenny each of whom is
respectively liable to or charged with the
annual payment of more than £5 in respect
of Rent Charge in lieu of Composition for
Tithes in said Parish caused a notice
in writing signed by them to be posted
on two successive Sundays viz on Sunday
the 18th September 1870 and Sunday the 25th
September 1870 pursuant to the Statute in
that case made and provided the last
of such Sundays being more than eight
days previous to the day of holding the
Quarter Sessions of the Peace at Thomastown
on the 17th day of October 1870 being the next
ensuing Sessions after the posting of such
