the 14th day of Feb^r 1833 Desiring to conclude the former payment
of all tythe or Composition for tythe charged or to be charged and pay-
able out of all that and those the Lower Land of Kiltilla, Kanyra,
Kneekolla, and Bruckish, and the half quarter land of Tublaghilly,
also the 2^d Land of Mahragellan, the 2^d Land of Mahraclough,
and the 2^d Land of Glanallyn all Situate in the Parish of Tub-
laghilly and County of Down as the same are particularly
described by a Map or Plan that or ground plan annexed herunto,
pursuant to the provisions of an Act made the 2^d and 3^d years of the
Reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th Chap. 119th providing
for the Est. blishing of Composition for tythes in Ireland, in order that
you may be entitled upon the terms therein provided to the reduction
of 15 per Cent upon said tythe or Composition for tythe then by you,
and I declare you pursuant to said Act to be entitled to the benefit
