by the Bishop of said Diocese and £29^l 11^s 5^d is due
and payable to James Keilly Esq^r as lay Proprietor
of said Parish

And I do further Certify that the average price
of wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County for
the period of 7 years ending the 1st day of November 1830 is £12^s 0^d
per Barriell
