the Tithes claimed by him as Curate of said parish appointed
by the Bishop of said Diocese and £ 29¹¹ 3¹¹ 3 is due & payable to
James O'Reilly Esquire as lay impropriator of said parish.

And I do further Certify that the average price of
wheat being the corn principally grown in such County for
the period of seven years ending the first day of November
in the year 1830 is £ 1¹¹ 12⁰ 0¹ 2 per Barrel
