 Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to
 fix & maintain a true & just rate of Composition for all
 Tithes arising growing, yielded or payable within the
 Parish of Tullyhastan, Diocese of Down & County Down
 Do hereby Certify that the true & just rate of the
 Macdonald Tithes are Two Hundred & fifty pounds per
 annum is due & payable to the Rector of said
 Parish for the Tithes claimable by him
 for the term of Twenty One years and we do fur-
 ther Certify that the average price of Wheat being the
 corn principally grown in the County Down for the
 period of seven years ending the 5th day November 1821 was
 £1. 18. 8¹/₂ per Bushel.
