We do therefore order adjudge and Decree that the said like Kent Charge in lieu of said like Composition be diminished by a sum of Sixty three pounds thirteen shillings and eight pence annually as calculated by the Counsel of the said Reverend Charles Butler Stevenson and agreed to before us and that the same shall now be Three hundred and twenty one pounds one shilling and four pence annually instead of Three hundred and eighty four pounds fifteen shillings said sum of Three hundred and twenty one pounds one shilling and four pence to be paid and payable to the party or parties entitled thereto in the same manner and proportions as the said original like Composition and Kent Charge in lieu thereof had been heretofore payable and that the same shall commence and be payable from the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and fifty four and We do further order that the assessment and apportionment of the said like Kent Charge in lieu of like Composition shall be reduced and diminished so as to bear the like proportions to the said sum of Three hundred and twenty one pounds one shilling and four pence being the said reduced like Kent Charge in lieu of like Composition as the said original assessment and apportionment did to the original like Composition — Given under my hand and Seal at the quarter sessions held at Graces old Castle Kilkenny aforesaid this twenty third day of October One thousand eight hundred and fifty four
